Students must complete the survey before they are given access to their course grades. Students who do not complete the survey for each of their courses during the course survey period will not be able to check their course grades. 1. Course Survey Period and Students' View & Appeal for Final Grade

Course Survey Period: Jan. 13th(Fri.) ~ Jan. 24th(Tue.)

Students can check their final grades from Jan. 19th(Thu.) to Jan. 24th(Tue.)

■ Winter Abroad at Yonsei(WAY)

Session 1: Jan. 13th(Fri.) ~ Jan. 24th(Tue.)

Students can check their final grades from Jan. 19th(Thu.) to Jan. 24th(Tue.)

Session 2: Feb. 10th(Fri.) ~ Feb. 21st(Tue.)

Students can check their final grades from Feb. 17th(Fri.) to Feb. 21st(Tue.)

※ Students can view their final grades only if they have completed the course survey.
